



The 2017 AIA Connecticut Award for Emerging Architects

The purpose of this award is to recognize and support emerging, graduate architects who have made outstanding, innovative contributions to their practice or profession or have rendered distinguished service in the public realm.

Eligibility: Candidates must have attained an architectural degree from an accredited architectural school, be working toward licensure in Connecticut, and be employed by a state-based AIA Connecticut firm or by an allied professional firm or institution.

Supporting Statement: 250 words or less and including a description of the contributions, impact, and public recognition of the candidate’s endeavors, if any:

Nomination Deadline: Thursday, June 1, 2017

Fee: \$15.00 for first nomination; \$10 for subsequent nominations.

The recipient of the award will be entitled to one year’s free membership in both AIA and AIA Connecticut.
