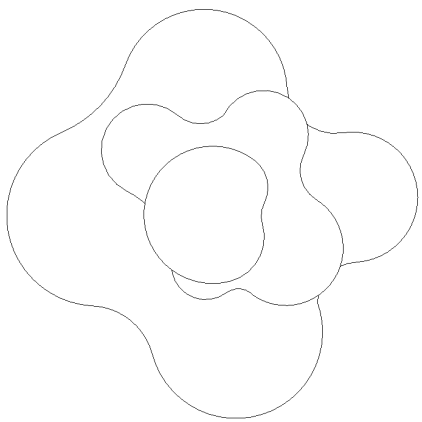


# Pet Habitat

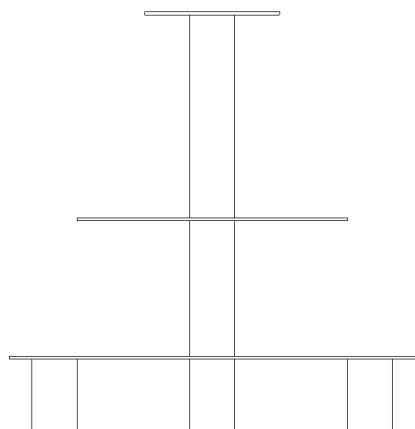

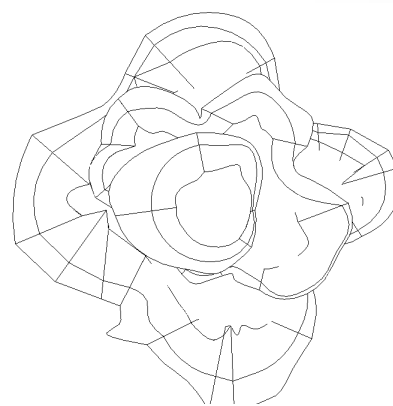
